

Camp Dress and Conduct Policy

RULES REGULATING ON SIGHT CAMPERS AND/OR PERSONS WHO ATTEND ANY CAMP SESSIONS DURING THE CAMP YEAR

1 - All campers must have the recommendation of a United Pentecostal Church Pastor to attend.

2 - No camper shall be permitted to stay on the Campgrounds without being enrolled. If permitted to stay in a cabin full registration fee must be paid.

3 - Campers are not to stay in any cottage without an adult counselor officially approved by the Camp Director in charge. Campers are not to visit or be present at any time in a cottage where members of the opposite sex are present or reside.

4 - Campers shall be required to eat their meals in the cafeteria at the approved time.

5 - No camper shall be permitted in any area of the Campgrounds beyond the boundary established by the Camp in session without special permission of the officials in charge.

6 - Costume jewelry is not to be worn by campers or staff.

7 - Girls registered at any camp must have all dresses decent and below the knees when sitting. Dresses and blouses must have sleeves. No sleeveless, capped sleeves, see through, tight fitting or low cut blouses or shirts are allowed. Girls may not wear shorts, gauchos or slacks on the campgrounds. Slits in skirts must not be above the knee. No midriffs are to be exposed.

8 - No suggestive slogans or pictures are allowed on clothing or else- where.

9 - We disapprove of girls cut, trimmed or unkempt stringing hair and ask all Holy Ghost filled campers to respect this standard and set forth an example for all to follow. The use of lipstick or makeup shall not be permitted.

10 - Boys must have decent haircuts, having their hair off the ears and collar. No tight fitting jeans or pants shall be permitted. All sweat suits must have shorts over them for the sake of modesty. We also encourage a neat groomed appearance and well-combed hair for all our young men as setting forth good example for all to follow. Boys may not wear shorts or cut-offs. Shirts must have sleeves. (No tank tops allowed.)

11 - Recreational activities involving both boys and girls shall only be allowed by permission of the officials of the Camp in session.

12 - No tape players, CD players, radios, portable music players, Hand-held video games, cell phones, other communication devices or inappropriate printed materials will be allowed on the campground.

****NOTE:** Possession of any of these items could result in immediate dismissal from camp. We reserve the right to inspect contents of all personal belongings. The holding and disposal of improper contents is the right of the camp staff. All searches will be conducted in the presence of the camp director.

13 - Men serving on Staff must be clean shaven.

14 - Because of a world reflecting wrong examples, the Michigan District Board strongly suggests that all ministers and their wives and lay people set forth an example of modesty in dress and presentation of holiness in example.
