

## Camping Rules & Information

1. Check-in at the Guard Shack upon arrival and fill out registration form. Pay at this time unless pre-paid. Make checks payable to: Michigan District UPCI
2. Camp only on designated sites.
3. Camping permits begin at 2:00 PM on the day of check-in and check-out time is 1:00 PM
4. Everyone staying in this area must register with Danny McCool, Trailer Coordinator, during all camps. There will be no additional charge for registration, other than stated fees (meals not included) unless during the week of Crusaders, Junior High or Senior High Camps or Ladies Retreat.
5. All Campers and tents must be parked in the trailer park service area. No campers, tents, or trailers will be allowed to park adjacent to cabins, in the streets or empty cabin lots (without permission of the District Board). Limit of one car, van, or SUV on each lot.
6. Quiet hours are: 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM
7. Radios, generators, or other amplifying devices may not be used in a manner that creates excessive noise.
8. Fireworks are not permitted on grounds.
9. Discharge of firearms, air guns, slingshots, or arrows are not permitted within campground boundaries.
10. Dogs must be on a leash no more than six feet long: They must be attended at all times. No dogs are permitted in the central campground.
11. Only one vehicle per camp site.
12. Please read and adhere to our District Camp Dress and Conduct Policy.
13. Any children or youth staying in a trailer must have adult supervision and pay the full registration fee if staying there during the week of Crusaders, Junior High, or Senior High Camps.
14. **In case of Tornado sirens, please report immediately to the Tabernacle for safety.**
